1. ACCEPTANCE OF CROTEGA TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Crotega, LLC ("Crotega") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy Statement sets forth our current privacy practices with regard to the information we collect when you or your computer interact(s) with our website ("Website").

2. ACCESS ACCEPTANCE

Your access to and use of Crotega's Website is exclusively to these Terms and Conditions. You will not use the Website for any purpose that is unlawful or prohibited by these Terms and Conditions. 4. COLLECTION AND USE OF INFORMATION

Crotega collects certain information from and about its users as follows: Website Server Logs, Personal Information, and Use of Cookies.

- a) Website Server Logs: When you visit our Website, Crotega may track information to administer the site analytics usage. Examples we may track include:

- *Your Internet protocol address
- *Name of your Internet service provider
- *Date and time of your visit
- *State from which you accessed the site
- *The kind of browser or computer used
- *Web page you linked to our site from
- *Pages viewed on the site
- *Number of links you click within a site

- b) Personal Information Users:

Visitors to Crotega' Website can register to purchase products and services. When you register, we will request some personal information such as name, address, email, telephone number, account number, and other relevant information. If you are purchasing a product or service,

we will request financial information. Any financial information we collect is used only to bill you for the products or services you purchased. If you purchase by credit card, this information may be forwarded to your credit card provider. For other forms of registration, we will ask for the relevant information. You may also be asked to disclose personal information so that we can provide assistance and information to you. For example, such data may be warranted in order to provide online technical support.

We will not disclose personal information we collect from you to third parties without your permission except to the extent necessary including:
